Mr. Monaghan reported that he declared a state of emergency in Nevada County on January 11, 2017 and that the Town of Truckee and the City of Grass Valley also declared a state of emergency due to the severe storm impacts. Costs to the County Public Works Department due to storm damage have at this time reached about \$500,000.

Supervisor Anderson provided an update on the status of the State of Emergency in the Town of Truckee.
