SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the execution of a renewal master agreement with

the USDA Forest Service to provide campground patrol and controlled

substance enforcement on US Forest Service lands

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: Funding comes from the US Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest and reimburses certain salary expenses of the Sheriff's Office Operations budget during Fiscal Years 16/17 through 22/23. The General Fund will not be impacted.

BACKGROUND: This master agreement continues a working relationship between the Tahoe National Forest and the Nevada County Sheriff's Office that began in 1972. During the summer months when visitor activities in forest lands are at their peak, sheriff's deputies provide regular and routine patrols throughout the forest as well as conduct surveillance aimed at illegal drug activities. This resolution approves the five-year master agreement, beginning with the date of the last signature on this master agreement and ending September 30, 2022. Exhibit A, in the amount of \$12,000, provides reimbursement for the yearly campground patrol, covering the period from the date of the last signature on Exhibit A, through September 30, 2017. Exhibit B, in the amount of \$12,000, provides reimbursement for controlled substance enforcement operations, covering the period from the date of the last signature on Exhibit B, through September 30, 2017. Each federal fiscal year during the term of the master agreement we expect to receive a new Exhibit A & B, with the reimbursement amounts yet to be determined.
