The regional partners include: Growers Alliances from Humboldt, Mendocino, Sonoma, Sierra, Placer, San Francisco, Oakland, Tuolumne and Santa Cruz Counties among others. On these weekly calls we discuss policy developments and regional regulations. I believe that this broad scope statewide knowledge can be valuable to the CAG discussions.

In addition to leading our weekly regional leadership calls; I observe the weekly policy committee calls. These weekly conversations provide updates as to the latest in Cannabis regulation across the state. It will be important to bring this information into the CAG discussions.

• Please explain why you wish to serve on the County's Community Advisory Group. For nearly the past two years I have been meeting with stakeholders from a variety of perspectives and experiences to better understand how Cannabis in Nevada County has

been affecting those in our community, their families and their work. I have sat down with fire fighters, police chiefs, school principals, members of our mental health prevention teams, and addiction services professionals. I have met with representatives from our non-profit world, elected officials and county staff. It is a core belief of mine that we cannot create policy until the needs of all stakeholders are addressed. It all begins with understanding and hearing each others perspectives. I wish to serve on the CAG to bring to the table the experience of what I have learned through my discussions with the various stakeholders around the county. I believe my knowledge can be helpful as we move forward to create recommendations that bring diverse perspectives into the plan.

I have spoken to fish and game officers who have seen dead bears that have been shot on cultivation sites. These are the hard conversations that are I must have in order to properly advocate for impactful change in Nevada County so that we can create solutions. Having these discussions has inherently made it essential to be open to other perspectives and experiences.





Cannabis Cultivation in Nevada County
My View
Terri Hicklin

When I moved to No. Columbia from Sacramento in the mid-eighties, it didn't take long for me to become aware that many of the folks living nearby were growing what has been historically called "weed." This was in the days before the distinction between "weed" and "medicinal cannabis" existed, though I'm sure the many healing properties of "weed" were one of the reasons it has been used so widely, by so many different types of folks over many, many years (including my conservative, "Greatest Generation," WWII veteran father who used it way back in the late 70's, after learning that cannabis could help with his severe arthritis).

These neighbors were mostly "back-to-the-land" folks, who used "best practices" in their gardens, be they growing carrots and tomatoes, or cannabis. Usually, they were growing large, mixed gardens, using organic methods. The idea of pesticides and chemicals was (and is) abhorrent to most cannabis gardeners and small farmers. Rest assured, anyone using commercial pesticides and "Miracle Gro" type products is more than likely in it for the money!

Over the next ten years or so, I began hearing more and more about "gorilla grows," - on public lands where people were quite literally carrying in water, etc. By the early 2000's, rumors surfaced about large, "sketchy" "cartel-style" grows, and residents started to be afraid to wander in the woods. Large-scale grows had exploded! People from other states and even other countries began to rush to the area and buy up property, or rent large acreage. Unfortunately, these large-scale grows, mostly on public lands, were allowed by law enforcement to proliferate. Who knows why? Maybe law enforcement did not have enough staff to get things under control early in the game. I remember often reading about the sheriff's office discovering large grows on public lands, and their statements that nobody was around so no arrests were made, and only the plants were eradicated. Many in the community wondered why the "powers that be" never seemed to go after these criminals. During discussions on the subject, locals guessed at possible reasons such as law enforcement not wanting to deal with the I.N.S. and not having the "man-power" and/or ability to go after serious criminal organizations.

After so many years of allowing large-scale, criminal gardens to flourish unchecked, law enforcement now sees the issue as "urgent." Thus two "urgency" ordinances have been put in place in less than three years. It's kind of like closing the barn doors after the horse has gotten out.

The sheriff and members of the Board of Supervisors have stated that what they really want to do is chase out the "bad actors," - the truly criminal element that is raping our forests, destroying our wildlife and diverting our waterways. Unless you are one of those types, you would agree that there needs to be an end to this type of cultivation. For the most part, these are the "get-rich-quick" growers who have given the rest of the cannabis cultivators a bad name. These are the people we all want to see ran out of town, and preferably tarred and feathered on their way out. But that is not the majority of growers. Like it or not, times have changed, and those on both sides of the cultivation battle will need to adjust their thinking.

We can learn a lot from history. In 1920, the 18th Amendment to the Constitution forbade the "manufacture, sale, or transportation of intoxicating liquors." Think about that..one day, you could have an alcoholic beverage of your choice, the next...wham! Some folks who thought they knew best devised laws that changed the face of American history.

Through a loophole allowing each home to "make 200 gallons of non-intoxicating cider and fruit juice per year," thousands of otherwise law-abiding citizens became home winemakers and bootleggers. Why? Because the populace on the whole, felt they had the right to consume alcoholic beverages, and that the laws were over-reaching and unfair. Sound familiar?

The crime associated with Prohibition is legendary. We are now in a similar situation because of the long-standing laws around marijuana which was effectively criminalized in 1937. And yes, there are still folks in this day and age who think they know best about what adult Americans should be allowed to do, thereby alleviating our rights to Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness. I would hazard a guess that the "old guard" was outraged at the end of Prohibition. They probably felt it would be the "beginning of the end." But good things happened instead.

After the repeal of Prohibition, the now-flourishing California wine industry began to grow. From it's early beginnings in the 1960's, wines grown in California have become world-renowned, and the industry has helped California to become (currently) the world's 8th largest economy! There are many who look to California's craft cannabis industry as being the next, legitimate boon to the State's economy. Cannabis cultivation has proliferated here "behind closed doors" for going on 40 years. The time has come to allow this industry to come out into the light of day.

While learning from the past and looking to the future, California's lawmakers have spent thousands of hours crafting new state regulations. In a rare show of bipartisanship, State laws have been developed that will bring cannabis cultivation and commerce into a new era. Recreational use of marijuana was approved by the voters and made legal in California in the November election. So once again, the time's they are "a-changin'."

And the "bad actors" will have to come into compliance or face the consequences. Believe me when I tell you, the new paradigm will not go over well with many in the cannabis industry, but this is the wave of the future.

Prohibition didn't work then, and doesn't work now, especially in light of the huge changes coming down the pike that highlight, at long last, a general revision in thinking about the benefits of cannabis...an amazing plant that has a multitude of beneficial uses.

Locally, the idea of an across-the-board ban on outdoor growing will not solve the problem of the truly criminal element. Let's come to the table together to find reasonable solutions that will usher in the new era while driving out the truly "bad actors," and looking to the future for incentives that will be best for the land, water, economy and people of our fabulous Nevada County.

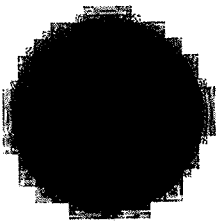


