MENTAL HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD (NEVADA COUNTY) Res. 93-195, 94-74, 94-75, 94-116, 94-117, 99-331, 99-332, 03-433, 09-592

The Nevada County Mental Health Advisory Board shall review and evaluate the community's mental health needs, services, facilities, and special problems; review any County agreements entered into pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5650; advise as to any aspect of the local mental health program; review and approve the procedures used to ensure citizen and professional involvement at all stages of the planning process; submit annual report; review and make recommendations on applicants for the appointment of Director of Mental Health Services; review and comment on the County's performance outcome data and communicate its findings to the State Mental Health Commission; and assess the impacts of the realignment services from the State to the County on services delivered to clients and on the local community.

The Board shall consist of eleven (11) members. The Board of Supervisors shall appoint ten (10) members, and designate two (2) to represent each supervisorial district. Members shall serve for 3 year terms. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors or his/her designee shall serve as the eleventh member plus the Chair shall also appoint another member of the Board of Supervisors to serve as alternate to the primary supervisor member. Members shall be appointed from a pool of applicants recommended by the Director of Behavioral Health and the Chairperson of the Mental Health Advisory Board who have experience and knowledge of the mental health and/or alcohol/drug system. At least 50% of the membership shall be consumers or the parents, spouse, sibling, or adult children of consumers who are receiving or have received mental health services. At least 20% of the total membership shall be consumers and at least 20% shall be families of consumers.
