The Need for Child Support

One quarter of the nation's children receive child support services

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Three quarters of single parent families with incomes below 200% of poverty receive child support services
- Support payments play a stabilizing role during economic downturns, helping families get from paycheck to paycheck

HEALTHY FAMILIES

- Health insurance to promote healthy children
- Has a positive effect on children's achievement in school
- Access to medical records and survivor benefits





Child Support Is:



The money paid by one or both parents to meet the needs of their children

- The second largest source of income for poor families
- The backbone of a family's budget





Child Support Provides

- Direct benefits to families
- Cost avoidance for other public assistance programs
- For healthier, more self sufficient families









How Child Support Benefits Families

- Children with the increased stability of regular child support payments are more successful in school.
- Parents who pay support are more likely to visit their children regularly and build stronger relationships with them.
- Consistent child support payments decrease conflict between parents and reduce the stress on children.





What is the Child Support Program?

- Rated by the Federal Office of Management and Budget as the best managed, most effective Social Services program
- A federally (66%) and state (34%) funded program that encourages families to become self-sufficient
- A multi-disciplinary program working in collaboration with other county departments, such as Social Services, Probation, and others



Services Provided

Child Support Services aids families in meeting their responsibilities to their children by providing:

- Establishment of parentage
- Establishment and modification of court orders for child support and health insurance
- Payment collection and distribution services
- Locate services





Collaborations and Other Services

- Regionalized office providing services for the residents of Sierra and Nevada counties.
- Operate as a call center for Plumas county Child Support Services.
- Prepare and serve all one-time lump sum wage garnishments of employer paid bonuses for the entire state.
- Complaint resolutions services for Inyo and Mono counties
- Annual free tax preparation for low to moderate income families
