**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing an amendment to the agreement with Amador County for confinement of Amador County inmates at the Nevada County Jail, to extend contract term from July 26, 2017 to July 26, 2018

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** Amador County will pay Nevada County to house inmates. Revenue is expected to cover expenditures. Revenue will impact the Sheriff's Corrections Division for FY 17/18 with a slight carryover into FY 18/19. There will be no negative impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** Amador County has experienced limited jail bed space in their facility for a number of years. A mutually beneficial agreement between Amador County and Nevada County was first executed pursuant to Resolution 14-330 to allow for certain sentenced inmates from Amador County to be housed in the Wayne Brown Correctional Facility (WBCF). A number of amendments were made to that agreement to extend the term of the agreement.

Resolution 16-375 authorized a new agreement which expires July 26, 2017. This proposed amendment would extend the term of that agreement for an additional year. Amador County's Board of Supervisors has already authorized and executed the agreement. The amendment will become effective on the date of the last signature.

Amador County will pay Nevada County \$70 per inmate, per day, to be housed at the WBCF. Nevada County must approve acceptance of the inmates at its jail in advance. Inmate transportation and medical costs will be borne by Amador County. Nevada County reserves the right to return any inmate to Amador jail at its sole discretion.
