### CONTRACT WITH HOSPITALITY HOUSE TO PROVIDE HOMELESS OUTREACH

- Funds outreach worker, transportation, supplies
- Visit homeless camps
- Talk to homeless people on the street
- Offer and link people to services
- 2015-2016 served 103 unduplicated people

#### Offers outreach and case management services

- Rapid rehousing
- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) application assistance
- Birth certificate and California ID fee waiver assistance
- Referral services
- Transportation
- Clothing and clothing vouchers
- Referrals
- Facilitation of services for medical, dental, behavioral health, money management, peer counseling and substance use treatment programs

# FORENSIC LIAISON OUTREACH WORKER

- Member of the Crisis Intervention Team (includes Law Enforcement, Probation, Behavioral Health)
- Street and jail outreach
- Offers services and case management
- Follows jail clients through the Court system
- Worked with 44 homeless individuals last year

# CONTRACT WITH TURNING POINT PROVIDENCE CENTER

- To provide homeless outreach
  - Offer services
  - Offer, subsidize, and arrange housing
- Treated 9 homeless clients last year
- Treated 16 Assisted Outpatient Treatment clients last year
- Currently 140 people in permanent supported housing

### TRUCKEE OUTREACH

- Share 2 Case Managers with Placer County:
  - Project Mana case manager served 17 unduplicated individuals at the Emergency Warming Center and 25 unduplicated individuals at the Food & Resource Support Center, connecting people in need to other services

## HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PEOPLE WITH AIDS

 Public Health reaches out to community members who are HIV/AIDS positive and assists with short-term needs:

- Rent
- Mortgage
- Utility payments

Served 14 low-income HIV-positive/AIDS clients



#### SPIRIT PEER EMPOWERMENT CENTER

- Provides basic needs to homeless individuals
  - Food
  - Showers
  - Laundry
- Case Management services
- Peer Counseling
- Served 587 community members 2016-2017
- 206 of those community members were homeless
- 35% of their clients are homeless



#### FUTURE PLANS AND HOPES

 Behavioral Health will bring a contract before the Board for two additional Case Managers to be outstationed at Hospitality House

- Providing outreach
- Linking clients to services and housing
- Offering supported housing
- SAMHSA Grant (Substance Abuse Mental Health Administration)
  - Applied for grant to serve the County's homeless population
  - Create a five-member team for homeless outreach
  - To secure housing for 30-40 individuals each year
