



#### OTHER ACCOMPLISHMENTS



- Responded to 22 of 39 specific service gaps identified by HPIG
- 8 Grants submitted for \$1,626,783
- 24/7 day center planning with multiple service providers
- Intensive outreach and engagement to community stakeholders

#### HOMELESS PLAN SUMMARY

Total Budget for 17/18: \$500K

1) Coordination of Services: Estimate \$25K

2) Housing: Estimate \$225K

3) Homeless Services Day Center: Estimate \$250K

### 1) COORDINATION OF SERVICES

#### Short Term, next 3-12 months:

- Coordinated case management; interagency; multidisciplinary team
- Explore additional grant funding
- Training for providers, agencies, programs




## 1) COORDINATION OF SERVICES (CONTINUED)

#### Long Term, next 12-24 months:

- Continued grant submission to secure funding for homeless initiatives
- Realign HHSA services to prioritize homelessness
- CDBG Technical Assistance Project

## 2) HOUSING



#### Short Term, next 3-12 months:

- Nomadic shelter for families, faith based community
- Fully utilize Bost House 19 bed facility, opened Dec 2017
- Hospitality House expansion (15-bed capacity) January 2018
- Housing First supported housing program

## 2) HOUSING (CONTINUED)

#### Long Term, next 12-24 months:

- Expand Housing First housing options; including medical respite
- Fund development of permanent housing; such as No Place Like Home



## 3) HOMELESS SERVICES DAY CENTER

#### Short Term, next 3-12 months:

A pilot homeless services day center



# **EPS** S EXT

#### 2018 **January 9<sup>th</sup>:** Bring funding of 15-bed winter emergency shelter expansion at Hospitality House to Board January 25th: Conduct annual Point in Time Count February 21<sup>st</sup>: No Place Like Home TA grant funding: \$75,000 for site planning, strategic plan development, etc. **March:** HUD application determination for Tahoe/Truckee Permanent Supportive Housing Program March 6<sup>th</sup>: Bring proposed Connecting Point contract to Board for Homeless Services Day Center planning & implementation
