OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, HOUSING AND DISABILITY ADVOCACY PROGRAM (HDAP) TO BE USED FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY SOARWORKS PROGRAM IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$81,897 OVER THREE (3) YEARS, UPON ACCEPTANCE, AND AVAILABLE FOR USE THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020

WHEREAS, Housing and Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP) funding is available through the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), authorized per Assembly Bill (AB) 1603 (Chapter 25, Statutes of 2016); and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Social Services Department applied and was approved for HDAP funding in the preliminary amount of \$81,897, which requires a 100% county match contribution; and

WHEREAS, the funded HDAP allocation will be used to support implementation and integration of SOARWorks, a program that will provide specialized case management and advocacy to individuals experiencing homelessness who may be eligible for social security or disability benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors accepts funds in the amount of \$81,897 to be used to support implementation and integration of SOARWorks Program into the County's Continuum of Care (CoC) in the total amount of \$81,897 over three years, upon acceptance, and available for use through June 30, 2020.

Funds to be deposited into revenue account: 1589-50105-494-1000/440450.
