RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT (EMPG) FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$145,086 WITH A 100% MATCHING FUND REQUIREMENT FOR USE DURING THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2017 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2018

WHEREAS, the U.S Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to assist state, local, and tribal governments to enhance their capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or man-made; and


WHEREAS, Resolution 15-396 approves individuals as authorized officials to execute applications and documents for Department of Homeland Security Programs; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County's application was approved by the California Emergency Management Agency on December 29, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada hereby directs:

- 1. That the County of Nevada accept the grant in the amount of \$145,086 for the grant period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
- 2. That the Director of Emergency Services is authorized to fulfill the requirements of the Fiscal Year 17 EMPG.
- 3. That the Auditor-Controller deposit grant funding in the amount of \$145,086 into the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Emergency Management Budget:
