Rules

- Open to all Nevada County residents with the exception of Nevada County Community Library Employees and their families
- All designs must be completed using the provided template .
- Design may consist of a poem or artwork inspired by poetry.
- All artwork must be original, previously unpublished, and free of copyright restrictions
- Must include the words "Nevada County Community Library" in a clear and legible manner. Total number of words not to exceed 25.
- Upon submission each entrant grants the Nevada County Community Library all rights to the artwork and consents that all artwork may be displayed and/or reproduced without limitation and without compensation.
- one entry per person.

Judging and Prizes

- Entries will be accepted Feb 12th - March 5th
- Winners will be announced March 15th
- Design qualities and characteristics to be judged: creativity, relevance, originality, reproducibility, and a clear positive message.
- The winners will be determined by a committee of library staff, community members and our county poet laureate, Molly Fisk
- Winning designs will be featured on an official Nevada County Community Library card
- Winners will be recognized by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors

Entry Categories

Prizes will be awarded to:

- 1 Youth (10 and under)
- 1 Teen (11-17)
- 1 Adult (18 and over)
- 1 Poet Laureate's choice from all entrants
