SUBJECT: Resolution approving Amendment No. 1 to the cooperative law enforcement master agreement #17-LE-11051360-018 between the Nevada County Sheriff's Office and the U.S. Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest related to campground patrol and controlled substances enforcement

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Adopt Resolution

FUNDING: Additional funding in the amount of \$24,000, is for October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018 and impacts the Sheriff's Operations budget. Operational expenses will be reimbursed by the U.S. Forest Service.

BACKGROUND: We commonly refer to this agreement as our "Campground Patrol" or "High Country Patrol." This mutually beneficial working relationship between the Tahoe National Forest and Nevada County Sheriff's Office began in 1972. During the summer months when visitor activity to the county and forest lands is at its peak, sheriff deputies provide regular and routine patrols throughout the forest as well as conduct surveillance aimed at illegal narcotics activity.

This resolution is the first amendment to the five-year master agreement authorized by Resolution 17-154, and modifies both Exhibit A and Exhibit B by establishing the reimbursement amount for Federal Year 17 by \$12,000 each, bringing the total reimbursement amount to \$24,000.

The operational period for these reimbursement monies is from October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018.
