SUBJECT: Resolution Proclaiming May 31 through June 3, 2018, as "Celebration of Trails Weekend 2018" in Nevada County in Conjunction with "National Trails Day"

BACKGROUND:

Trails have a long history in Nevada County, first serving as routes for communication and commerce by Native Americans and later providing the means by which adventurers and immigrants came to explore and settle the territory that would become California. Today, trails-based recreational activities bring a variety of benefits that improve our quality of life and attract visitors to our county.

"Celebration of Trails Weekend 2018" coincides with the American Hiking Society's "National Trails Day." This year, the Bear Yuba Land Trust is hosting a "Celebration of Trails Weekend" that spans four days, from May 31 through June 3. This celebration includes a Fireside Chat on Thursday, May 31, an all-day Festival and first annual Hike-A-Thon on Saturday, June 2, and, on Sunday, June 3, treks, rides, and work days for all ages and abilities will take place at various locations in western Nevada County. Most events are free, and all events provide an opportunity for residents and visitors to become familiar with trails and trails-related organizations in our area.
