SUBJECT:Amendment No. 1 to the Contract with Dokken Engineering to Provide
Design and Environmental Support During Construction of the Shady
Creek at Purdon Road Bridge Replacement Project

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Approve the attached resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The funding for this amendment is primarily from the federal Highway Bridge Program. The contract amendment is for \$21,775.34, and there are sufficient CP budget available in FY 17/18.

BACKGROUND: On May 30, 2014, the County issued a Request for Qualifications for professional engineering services that included project management, design, environmental, right of way, and bid and construction support services for the Shady Creek at Purdon Road Bridge Replacement Project. On December 2, 2014 the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 14-532, approving a contract with Dokken Engineering for engineering support services for the project for \$323,340.51. Dokken has completed design, right of way, environmental clearance, and bid support services for the Project, with \$18,671 remaining in the contract. The project is now ready to move into the construction support phase, and County staff are requesting an amendment to the contract to provide engineering and environmental support during construction. With the credit, the total amendment request of \$21,775.34 would provide a total of \$40,446.34 for responding to requests for information, reviewing shop drawings, preparing as-built plans, providing environmental compliance support, and completing a record of survey for the new bridge, alignment and right-of-way if needed.

Staff is therefore requesting an amendment to increase Dokken's contract by \$21,775.34 for work proposed in 2018.
