## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES PROGRAM MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM, TO FUND THE SOUTH YUBA CANYON EMERGENCY NEEDS PROJECT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$86,670 FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2018 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Services is responsible for maintaining safety in the County and the County of Nevada has a severe and present danger of wildfire becoming a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Yuba River Public Safety Cohort Meetings have provided staff a unique insight to public safety needs along the Yuba River; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Services worked in collaboration with community partners identifying aspects of the South Yuba Canyon Emergency Needs Project; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Services sought and identified funding through Federal, State and community level funding through grants and donations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Nevada County, that the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services Program Manager is authorized to submit an application for the Department of Homeland Security's Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Program in the total amount of \$86,670 to fund the South Yuba Canyon Emergency Needs Project, for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, and authorizes the Chief Information Officer to execute for and on behalf of the County of Nevada this application and any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by this Department of Homeland Security Grant. The acceptance of this Grant will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval per County policy.
