OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND DESCHAINED ENTERPRISES, INC., FOR THE ERIC ROOD ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER WEST ENTRY ADA RAMP AND PARKING UPGRADE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$33,694 PLUS A CONTINGENCY OF \$3,370, FOR A TOTAL COMMITMENT OF \$37,064 AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, construction documents were prepared and approved through Resolution 18-164 for the project known as the Eric Rood Administrative Center West Entry ADA Ramp and Parking Upgrade Project; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were solicited and two timely bids for this project were received and opened on May 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid was disqualified due to an incomplete bid submission and the next responsive and responsible bid was from Deschaine Enterprises, Inc., of Grass Valley, with a bid in the amount of \$33,694; and

WHEREAS, the contract will be in the bid amount of \$33,694 plus a 10% contingency of \$3,370 for a maximum contract amount of \$37,064; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is included and will be paid out of the Facilities Management Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget and a budget amendment is not required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby directs that:

1. The contract for the Eric Rood Administrative Center West Entry ADA Ramp and Parking Upgrade Project located at 950 Maidu Avenue, Nevada City, California, in the amount of \$33,694 plus a contingency of \$3,370 for a total contract amount of \$37,064 be awarded to Deschaine Enterprises, Inc., 111 Bank Street #206, Grass Valley, California, 95945.
2. The Board approves and the Board Chair is authorized to execute a Nevada County standard public works contract on behalf of Nevada County with Deschaine Enterprises, Inc., upon receipt, approval, and acceptance of the bonds and certificates of insurance.
3. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to execute change orders pursuant to Article 9 of the Contract, up to the total contingency amount of \$3,370.
4. Contractor shall commence the work 10 days after mailing of written notice to proceed by County. All work shall be completed and ready for acceptance on or before 45 days of the mailing of the Notice to Proceed.
