SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing renewal of revenue Agreement No. 17-0549-031-SF with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to fund County European Grapevine Moth (EGVM) trapping, in the amount of \$10,392.00 for the period of January 1 2018, through December 31, 2018.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Adopt the Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: This revenue is included in the County Agricultural Commissioner's budget for Fiscal Years 2017/18 and 2018/19 and is provided by CDFA. No budget amendment is needed. There is no impact to the General Fund.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) provides reimbursement for various programs under the direction of the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures to help off-set the cost to counties for mandated programs.

This contract will provide funding for the Agricultural Commissioner to place and service EGVM traps in commercial vineyards at a density of 25 traps per square mile. Trapping areas are limited to commercial vineyards and wineries, which are considered high risk areas. EGVM is a pest known to cause economic damage to grapes (*Vitis* spp) and has been found, in the past, in a commercial winery facility in Nevada County. The State provides all traps, trap parts and lures, in addition to technical assistance and training for County staff.
