## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF REVENUE AGREEMENT NO. 17-0549-031-SF WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (CDFA) TO FUND COUNTY EUROPEAN GRAPEVINE MOTH (EGVM) TRAPPING, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,392.00, FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2018, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018

WHEREAS, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) provides reimbursement for various programs under the direction of the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures to help off-set the cost to counties for mandated programs; and

WHEREAS, this contract will provide funding for the Agricultural Commissioner to place and service EGVM traps in commercial vineyards at a density of 25 traps per square mile. Trapping areas are limited to commercial vineyards and wineries, which are considered high risk areas. EGVM is a pest known to cause economic damage to grapes (*Vitis* spp) and has been found, in the past, in a commercial winery facility in Nevada County. The State provides all traps, trap parts and lures, in addition to technical assistance and training for County staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the County of Nevada, that certain Agreement (CDFA-No.17-0549-031-SF) pertaining to providing trapping activities for the European Grapevine Moth (EGVM) in the County of Nevada in the maximum reimbursement amount of \$10,392.00, for the period of January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018, and direct revenue to be deposited into:
