COUNTYWIDE REDEVELOPMENT OVERSIGHT BOARD (NEVADA COUNTY)

Health & Safety Code Section 34179(j)(1-7); Res.

The function of the Oversight Board is to review actions taken by the Redevelopment Successor Agencies of Grass Valley and Truckee, with its primary role being the approval of the annual Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS), which lists the various outstanding financial obligations of the Successor Agencies that are authorized and legally committed to meet for the stated time period under review, as per Health and Safety Code Section 34179.

Health and Safety Code Section 34179(a) provides that the Countywide Redevelopment Dissolution Oversight Board is to be comprised of seven members appointed by affected local taxing entities and the community that established the redevelopment agency, including 1) one member appointed by the Board of Supervisors; 2) one public member appointed by the Board of Supervisors; 3) one member appointed by the City Selection Committee established pursuant to GC Section 50270; 4) one member appointed by the Special District Selection Committee established pursuant to GC Section 56332; 5) one member appointed by the Superintendent of Schools; 6) one member appointed by the Chancellor of California Community Colleges; and 7) one member appointed by the recognized employee organization representing the largest number of Successor Agency employees. Each member serves at the pleasure of the appointing entity.
