SUBJECT: Resolution amending Resolution No. 87-183 and 92-570, amending the Nevada County Fish and Wildlife Commission By-Laws

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: N/A

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Fish and Wildlife Commission is currently operating with many vacancies on the commission. Meetings have been canceled due to the inability to have a quorum present. After many months and attempts to fill these vacancies the Commission felt that operating with five (5) members, reduced from nine (9), would result in a more efficient commission. No members on the commission will be forced out unwillingly due to this reduction of size. In addition, the Commission revised the recommended by-laws so that each Supervisor may appoint one member from residents of the County at-large. However, no more than two (2) members from any one supervisorial district are allowed.

The Fish and Wildlife Commission is also in the process of additional revisions to their Bylaws in order to provide clarity as to the Commission's purpose, the Commission's process of recommending an annual budget to the Board of Supervisors, as well as general language cleanup. This reduction in size of the Commission will allow the Commission to establish a quorum more easily and complete those revisions. These revisions will be brought to the Board of Supervisors at a later date once reviewed by County Counsel.
