OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION A-II 2.2.A OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER II OF THE NEVADA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING BOARD OF SUPERVISOR COMPENSATION

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

Subsection 2.2.A of Section A-II of Article 2 of Chapter II of the Administrative Code of the County of Nevada, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. A-II 2.2. Compensation – Board of Supervisors

A. Members of the Board of Supervisors shall receive the annual salaries set forth below, effective as of the dates indicated below:

Effective as of August 25, 2018: Member, Board of Supervisors, \$53,667 annually. Chairperson, Board of Supervisors, \$56,350 annually.

Effective as of January 12, 2020: Member, Board of Supervisors, \$56,350 annually. Chairperson, Board of Supervisors, \$59,168 annually.

Effective as of January 10, 2021 Member, Board of Supervisors, \$59,168 annually. Chairperson, Board of Supervisors, \$62,126 annually.

SECTION II:

Severability. If any provision of this Article or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Article, including the application of such part or provision to other circumstances shall not be affected thereby and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, provisions of this Article are severable. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof irrespective of the fact that any one (1) or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be held unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable.

SECTION III:

Pursuant to Government Code Section 25123.5, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the expiration of sixty (60) days from and after its passage, and it shall become operative on the 25th day of August, 2018, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the Supervisors voting for and against same in THE UNION, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Nevada.
