OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPOINTING LINDA MILLER TO THE NEVADA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Formation Commission's (LAFCo's) Municipal Service Review for the Nevada County Resource Conservation District outlined that the potential cost of elections in both Nevada and Sierra counties could pose a tremendous financial burden on the Resource Conservation District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 9314(b)(1), the Nevada County Resource Conservation District Board of Directors, at its May 9, 2006, regular meeting, adopted Resolution 96-01, changing the method of selection of its Board of Directors from elected to appointed officials and requesting the County of Nevada Board of Supervisors to appoint Directors; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada Board of Supervisors, at its July 11, 2006, meeting, took action to appoint director positions to the Nevada County Resource Conservation District; and

WHEREAS, one position on the Nevada County Resource Conservation District became vacant on April 24, 2018, and the notice of vacancy was posted as required by law; and

WHEREAS, one application was submitted to the Board of Supervisors.

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Resource Conservation District Board recommends approval of the appointment of Linda Miller to the District Board.

WHEREAS, The Sierra County Board of Supervisors also recommends approval of the appointment of Linda Miller to the District Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada hereby appoints Linda Miller to an unexpired term on the Nevada County Resource Conservation District, June 19, 2018, through November 27, 2020.
