

**NEVADA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

**\*ADULT AND FAMILY SERVICES COMMISSION:** (2 vacancies and 3 positions) One Private Sector vacancy position to fill a 2-year unexpired term ending April 30, 2019 and one Private Sector vacancy position to fill a 2-year term ending April 30, 2020. One Public Sector position and Two Low-Income Sector positions to fill 2-year terms ending April 30, 2020. **\*CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT PLANNING COUNCIL:** (5 positions) One Child Care Provider member position, one Community member position, one Consumer member position, one Discretionary member position, one Chair of the Board of Supervisors Public Agency representative. All positions to fill 2-year terms ending June 30, 2020. The purpose of this council shall be to identify child care and development services' priorities to enhance cooperation among children's services, interest groups and agencies, develop a strategic long-range plan for a broad spectrum of child care and development services, and advocate the support of child care and development services at the local, state and federal levels of government. The purpose will be to review and recommend proposed revisions and additions to the sewage disposal regulations or sewage disposal ordinance in an advisory capacity; review and recommend new methods, techniques, and materials for on-site sewage disposal, in an advisory capacity; and serve as an appeal body under the provisions of Section A-032 of County Resolution 98-217.
