

County Office of Emergency Service Plans

- Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (912 pages long)
 - The County as a **community** identified risks/threats and the options to mitigate them before they become an emergency/disaster
- Emergency Operations Plan (52 pages long)
 - How the County as an organization responds to local emergencies/disasters when they occur



Hazard Mitigation Plan Goals

- Minimize risk and vulnerability of Nevada County to natural hazards and protect lives and prevent losses to property, public heath, economy, and the environment.
- Increase community outreach, education, and awareness of risk and vulnerability to hazards and promote participation and voluntary compliance to reduce hazard-related losses.
- Improve communities' capabilities to prevent/mitigate hazard-related losses and to be prepared for, respond to, and recover from a disaster event.

Hazard Mitigation Plan Goals (Cont.)

- Reduce fire severity and intensity in Nevada County
- Improve community resiliency to flooding in Nevada County
- Maintain FEMA eligibility for grant funding





Hazard Mitigation

- FEMA defines Hazard Mitigation as "any sustained action taken to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to human life and property from a hazard event."
- Local Hazard Mitigation Plans must be updated and approved by FEMA every 5 years.
 - August 2016 Nevada County OES secured a FEMA Grant to update August 2012 Mitigation Plan.
 - August 2017 Draft Mitigation Plan submitted to Cal OES and FEMA.
 - May 2, 2018 Nevada County Mitigation Plan was approved by FEMA.
