FROM: e SUBJECT:	Keith Royal, Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator Resolution authorizing Assignment, Consent and Amendment by and among Metroplex Control Systems, Inc. and ISI Controls, Ltd. each a/k/a Argyle Security Group (collectively with its parent and subsidiaries, "Argyle") and Corrections Technology Group, LLC. ("CTG") to contract with ISI Controls Ltd/Argyle Security previously adopted by Resolution 15-506 to provide jail security system maintenance

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

FUNDING: Jail security system maintenance is a mandatory service included in the Sheriff's Correction's FY 18/19 budget. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND:

The jail security system at the Wayne Brown Correctional Facility is a highly technical system of doors and locks which can be operated automatically or manually if necessary. In order to keep the security system in good working order regular maintenance is needed.

Argyle Security has provided services to maintain our jail security systems in optimal condition, as well as providing emergency repair services on short notice. We recently learned that Argyle Security is no longer in business. Argyle Security has signed the enclosed Assignment, Consent and Amendment to Corrections Technology Group, LLC. (CTG). CTG has agreed to retain the Argyle Security contract terms.

The contract term ends on November 1, 2018. We likely will return to the Board with an extension of the agreement through the end of the fiscal year to allow us time to go out to RFP for these services.
