- Ban all open fire in the Yuba River Wild and Scenic Corridor
 - 39 miles long from Lake Spaulding to Englebright Lake
 - ¹/₄ mile (1,320 feet) from the ordinary high water of the river's edge on both sides of the river
- Exceptions to the ban would include:
 - Provided pedestal grills and fire rings in designated areas in an organized public or private campground
 - Cooking fires built inside an enclosed stove, grill, barbecue or portable brazier located on a business or residential property with an accompanying resident or owner that is located within 20 feet of the residence or business building in an area at least five feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all non-structural flammable material in all directions. Note: This text would prohibit property owners from using fire rings on their property.
- Ban would be in effect from the Memorial Day weekend to the end of the fire season as declared by CalFIRE (2 inches of sustained rain)
