OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE AIRPORT HANGAR REPAIR (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, in the event of an emergency, Public Contract Code Sections 20134 and 22050(a) authorize the County, by a 4/5 affirmative vote of the Board of Supervisors, to repair or replace a public facility, take any directly related to or immediate action required by the emergency, and procure the necessary equipment, services, and supplies for said purposes, without giving notice for bids to let contracts; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2018, by Resolution 18-204, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors declared a local emergency due to a fire at a County-owned airport hangar ("the Airport Hangar Fire"), and the aforesaid emergency necessitates the need for the immediate expenditure of public monies to protect health, safety and property without complying with competitive bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, Degenkolb Engineering has prepared plans and specifications for the repair of the airport hangar roof, shell and door, which will be used to accomplish the work; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Facilities and Building Departments have reviewed the plans and specifications attached; and

WHEREAS, the hangar repair work is expected to be funded by insurance proceeds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada approves the plans and specifications for the Airport Hangar Repair.
