RESOLUTION DESIGNATING ARTS COLLABORATIVE OF NEVADA COUNTY DBA NEVADA COUNTY ARTS COUNCIL AS NEVADA COUNTY'S STATE-LOCAL PARTNER THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA ARTS COUNCIL STATE-LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM


WHEREAS, the California Arts Council (CAC) and the California State Legislature have established a State-Local Partnership program designed to increase public awareness and participation in the arts of all cultures and broaden public and private support for the arts, to serve the diverse cultural needs of California's local communities, to encourage and promote arts in education, to foster local and regional partnerships and collaboration and to provide funds to private non-profit organizations and municipal commissions that have been designated by local governments as partners in the promotion of the arts; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Arts Council has served as Nevada County's local partner since 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Arts Council has requested a resolution to continue as the County's local partner in CAC's State-Local Partnership Program to be eligible to receive CAC funding; and

WHEREAS, the Board's designation of the Nevada County Arts Council as a local partner does not require or imply the commitment of any County financial resources as a result of this designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada hereby designates the Nevada County Arts Council as Nevada County's local partner for the CAC State-Local Partnership Program, approves the submittal of an application by the Nevada County Arts Council to the CAC and designates the Nevada County Arts Council to execute the 2019-2020 CAC grant as approved by the California Arts Council.
