OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

APPROVE AMENDMENT 1 TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2018/19 LOCAL AGENCY PARTICIPATION SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEVADA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND NEVADA COUNTY

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2018, the Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted Resolution 18-409, approving a subrecipient agreement with the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) to document and formalize the terms and conditions of NCTC's reimbursement to the County for services outlined in the Overall Work Program (OWP) for an amount of \$17,500 for Regional Transportation Planning activities; and


WHEREAS, on September 19, 2018, NCTC approved an amendment to the OWP to include \$9,167 in additional funds for the development of a Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP) for Nevada County.

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2019, the Board adopted the LRSP.

WHEREAS, NCTC and Nevada County wish to amend the Agreement to increase the agreement amount from \$17,500 to \$26,667 to cover the agreed upon amount of \$9,167 for development of a countywide Local Road Safety Plan.

WHEREAS, funds, shall be deposited into account 1114-30104-702-1000/401500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approves Amendment 1, attached as exhibit 1, to the Subrecipient Agreement with the Nevada County Transportation Commission to be reimbursed for transportation planning activities and the development of the LRSP for a total amount of \$26,667 and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute Amendment 1 to Subrecipient Agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada.

AMENDMENT 1

TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2018/19 LOCAL AGENCY PARTICIPATION SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN NEVADA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND NEVADA COUNTY

This Amendment 1 to the July 1, 2018 Subrecipient Agreement ("Agreement") between the Nevada County Transportation Commission ("NCTC") and Nevada County is entered into effective May 28, 2019.

WHEREAS, NCTC and Nevada County entered into the FY 2018/19 Subrecipient Agreement for local participation in the Regional Transportation Planning process; and,

WHEREAS, NCTC and Nevada County wish to amend the Agreement to increase the agreement amount from \$17,500 to \$26,667 to cover the agreed upon amount of \$9,167 for development of a countywide Local Road Safety Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, NCTC and Nevada County agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of the Agreement ("Scope of Work") is amended to include a revised "Exhibit A".
- 2. Section 4 of the Agreement ("Funding Amount") is amended to read as follows:
 - a. Funding Amount: Under this Agreement, Subrecipient will be reimbursed by NCTC for Subrecipient's staff time related to local participation in the Regional Transportation Planning process, including development of a countywide Local Road Safety Plan. Subrecipient will also be reimbursed for all related consultant invoices paid by Subrecipient. NCTC shall pay Subrecipient in full for all services performed pursuant to this Agreement, a total sum not to exceed Twenty-Six Thousand, Six Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$26,667). Subrecipient will not perform work, nor be required to perform work, outside those services specified in this Agreement or which would result in billings in excess of \$26,667, without the prior written agreement of both parties. In no instance will NCTC be liable for any unauthorized or ineligible costs.
- 3. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
