#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

## Background

A historic abandoned mine feature opened up under a public county roadway in Grass Valley, Nevada County. There are no stormwater drains or sewers under the road that could be causing the subsidence. The feature consists of an approximately 3' diameter hole in one lane with a 2' to 3' vertical void under the asphalt of the roadway. The road must be excavated to determine the extent of the mine feature; however, the bottom of the mine feature was detected at approximately 8' down at approximately 40 degrees, then an additional estimated 5' down in another direction.

## **Overview**

Due to the risk of public exposure, the California Department of Conservation ("Department") will provide financial assistance to County of Nevada for the closure of the abandoned mine feature based on emergency services per State Contracting Manual Volume 1 Section 3.10. County of Nevada will contract with a qualified company to remediate the shaft as per the engineering design provided by NV5 Geotechnical Engineers and approved by the County Civil Engineer. The Department will reimburse Nevada County for contractor expenses up to \$25,000.00 to remediate the abandoned mine feature in the roadway in Nevada County.

County of Nevada will give the Department at least one days' notice before the construction begins. County of Nevada releases liability for the State of California, Department of Conservation with regards to this mine shaft remediation project.

The services shall be performed in the public road at 11674 LaBarr Meadows Road in Grass Valley, CA.

The term of this agreement is from June 13, 2019, or upon Department approval, whichever is later to July 15, 2019.

# Specific Requirements

- A. County of Nevada will contract with a qualified company to remediate the shaft as per the engineering design provided by NV5 Geotechnical Engineers and approved by the County Civil Engineer.
- B. County of Nevada shall provide the Department a copy of the field exploration data, a letter report summarizing findings and recommendation, and an as-built drawing detailing the completed closure at the time of invoicing or before.
- C. County of Nevada shall provide photos taken at significant stages during the excavation of the area; before, during, and after the concrete pour; and after the project is complete at the time of invoicing or before.
- D. County of Nevada shall to provide proof or receipt or invoices that work was performed and completed by Contractor before or at the time of invoicing.

#### **EXHIBIT B**

#### **BUDGET DETAIL AND PAYMENT PROVISIONS**

### 1. Invoicing and Payment

A. County of Nevada shall submit three (3) copies of the invoice to the Department upon successful completion of the remediation of the mineshaft. The Department agrees to reimburse Nevada County for contractor expense up to \$25,000.00.

This is a one time payment, in arrears.

B. The County of Nevada shall submit a one-time invoice for payment, in arrears to:

- C. An acceptable invoice must include:
  - Nevada County's name and address
  - Department's name and address
  - Department agreement number
  - Appropriate itemization, including date(s) for service
- D. The Department will verify and approve, or disapprove, the invoiced item(s). If the Department does not approve the invoiced item(s), the Department will dispute the invoice, per Prompt Payment Act, and provide opportunity to the Contractor to resolve the dispute.

# 2. Budget Contingency Clause

It is mutually agreed that if the Budget Act of the current year and/or any subsequent years covered under this Agreement does not appropriate sufficient funds for the program, this Agreement shall be of no further force and effect. In this event, the State may be unable to close abandoned mine openings and shall have no liability to pay any funds whatsoever to Contractor or to furnish any other considerations under this Agreement and Contractor shall not be obligated to perform any provisions of this Agreement.

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If funding for any fiscal year is reduced or deleted by the Budget Act for purposes of this program, the State shall have the option to either cancel this Agreement with no liability occurring to the State, or offer an agreement amendment to Contractor to reflect the reduced amount.

# 3. Prompt Payment Clause

Payment will be made in accordance with, and within the time specified in, <u>Government Code Chapter</u> 4.5, commencing with Section 927.
