**SUBJECT:** Resolution Accepting Funds up to \$25,000 per Agreement Number 6018-

006 and up to \$25,000 per Agreement Number 6018-007 From the California Department of Conservation, Division of Mine Reclamation

(DMR)

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**<u>FUNDING:</u>** This resolution is for acceptance of funding from DMR for up to a total of \$50,000. The work was completed in FY 18/19. A budget amendment is not needed and there is no impact to the County General Fund.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Approximately two months ago, Road crews noticed a depression in the asphalt near 11674 La Barr Meadows Road and assumed it was a typical pothole. Shortly after repairing the pothole, another depression occurred in the same location. This time, the depression was significantly larger and was evident that it was not a typical pothole. Staff contacted our on-call geotechnical consultant, NV5, who determined that the depression was due to a historic abandoned mine feature. We then contacted the California Department of Conservation, Division of Mine Reclamation (DMR) who have a program in place to help fund the closure of such mine features. Due to the need to address the emergency, Steve Monaghan, Director of Information and General Services acting as the purchasing agent, signed Standard Agreement Number 6018-006 with DMR in order to allow the road repairs to take place immediately utilizing up to \$25,000 in funding.

While preparing to address the first mine feature, another mine feature subsided further south on La Barr Meadows Road. Again, staff contacted DMR and signed Standard Agreement Number 6018-007 to allow the road repairs to take place immediately utilizing up to \$25,000 in funding.

The repairs were completed June 24th through June 26th and final costs are being accounted for.
