

## RESOLUTION No.

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN NEVADA COUNTY AND ALERTUS TECHNOLOGIES, LLC FOR AN EMERGENCY ALERT NOTIFICATION SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,097.50 FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF 36 MONTHS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019/20 INFORMATION SYSTEMS BUDGET (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, In 2018, the County Risk Manager hired an independent consultant to make recommendations regarding Emergency Preparedness for County Facility related emergencies such as an Active Shooter Situation; and

WHEREAS, the top recommendation from the consultant was the implementation of an Emergency Alert Notification System that provides notification methods such as silent desktop alerts, panic buttons, and telephone PA system alerts over time; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Alertus Technologies, LLC to implement an Emergency Alert Notification System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California:

- 1. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the County of Nevada the software contract with Alertus Technologies, LLC for implementation of an Emergency Alert Notification System in the amount of \$25,097.50 for an initial term of 36 months.
- 2. The Auditor-Controller is directed to release \$25,098 from the Information Systems Infrastructure Assignment of the General Fund and amend the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Information Systems budget as follows:
