**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of Amendment #1 to the Contract with Restpadd Health Corp. for the provision of 24-hour locked acute psychiatric services for residents of Nevada County who meet criteria for 5150 placement to increase the maximum contract price from \$25,000 to \$42,300 (an increase of \$17,300) and to amend Exhibit "B", "Schedule of Charges and Payments", to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price for the contract term of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** These services are mandated. The contract is supported by Behavioral Health's 2011 Realignment funds for Managed Care, Medi-Cal reimbursement, and 1991 Realignment as needed for referred uninsured indigent clients. A budget amendment is not necessary and there are no county general funds required in the Agreement.

**BACKGROUND:**

On August 17, 2018, the Nevada County Purchasing Agent approved a contract with Restpadd Health Corp. per Purchase Order Number PESM3636 to provide 24-hour locked acute psychiatric services for Nevada County residents.

Restpadd Psychiatric Health Facility (inpatient) offers services to adults, 18 years and older. Contractor's focus is on patient's strengths with individualized treatment plans; promote active family involvement and effective collaboration with patient's caregivers and support system.

Restpadd is a non-smoking, 16 bed acute care psychiatric inpatient treatment facility licensed by the State of California Department of Health Care Services. Admission is based on the medical necessity of patients who are unable to maintain and safely function at home or in the community.

Restpadd provides multi-disciplinary evaluation, treatment, rapid stabilization, and coordinated discharge planning that encourages wellness and recovery.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment which allows continuation of essential, mandated services for medically necessary inpatient services to eligible residents of Nevada County who have a mental illness and /or emotional disturbances that require acute psychiatric hospitalization services.
