**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving Amendment No. 3 (Modification No. 006) to the

Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement #17-LE-1105-1360-018 between the Nevada County Sheriff's Office and the U.S.D.A. Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest adopting the 2019 Controlled Substance

Annual Operating and Financial Plan.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

**<u>FUNDING:</u>** This is a reimbursement contract with the US Forrest Service in the amount of \$12,000. The operational period for reimbursement is from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019 with impacts to the Sheriff's Operations budget.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The County of Nevada approved a five (5) year Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement ("Agreement") with the US Forest Service on April 11, 2017, Resolution 17-154, to provide campground patrol, and surveillance of illegal narcotics activity, primarily during the summer months when visitor activity to the County and forest lands is at its peak. An approved Annual Operating and Financial Plan is required for each year during the term of the Agreement.

On April 24, 2018, Resolution 18-153 approved an amendment to the Agreement to provide for the Federal FY 2018 Annual Operating and Financial Plan. On May 28, 2019 Resolution 19-207 authorized Amendment #2 and approval of Exhibit A for provision of Campground Patrol. This resolution is to approve the third amendment to the Agreement, and modify Exhibit B by establishing the amount of reimbursement for Federal FY 2019 at \$12,000 for Controlled Substance Enforcement.
