

ORDINANCE NO.

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

ORDINANCE ADDING SUBSECTION 203 TO SECTION G-IV 3.A.3 OF ARTICLE 3.A OF CHAPTER IV OF THE NEVADA COUNTY GENERAL CODE PERTAINING TO SPEED LIMITS ON ROUGH AND READY HIGHWAY AND ADAM AVENUE – DISTRICT III

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

That the establishment of a 25 mile per hour prima facie speed limit on Rough and Ready Highway and Adam Avenue, be approved based on the following findings A-C:

- A. That the California Vehicle Code section 22352 establishes the prima facie speed limit at 25 mph in a school zone when children are present for any school grounds that are not separated from the roadway by a fence, gate, or other physical barrier while the grounds are in use by children and the roadway is posted with a standard "SCHOOL" warning sign;
- B. That establishing the speed limit at 25 mph in the school zone facilitates the safe movement of vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists, including children and their caregivers, in the school zone; and
- C. That the work to install new speed limit signs will be funded with local road maintenance funds for Fiscal Year 2019/20.

SECTION II:

Subsection 203 is hereby added to Section G-IV 3.A.3, of Article 3.A of Chapter IV of the Nevada County General Code to read as follows:

"Sec. G-IV 3.A.3 Twenty Five Miles Per Hour Prima Facie Speed Limit Established; Signs to be Posted

203. Rough and Ready Highway and Adam Avenue along the frontage with 10085 Adam Avenue, a school zone when children are present"

SECTION III:

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and adopted this ordinance and each section, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION IV:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days from and after introduction and adoption, and it shall become operative on the _____ day of ______, 2019, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the Supervisors voting for and against same in the Union, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Nevada.
