Read up! Literacy Program

- Began in 1998
- Provides:

✓ Adult Basic Education: Basic literacy and numeracy instruction/tutoring

Grade levels 1-12, including preparation for high school equivalency exams

✓ English as a Second Language (ESL): Instruction/tutoring

Adult learners with limited English language proficiency

✓ Workforce Preparation and Training: Instruction/tutoring

Provides literacy, numeracy, and workforce readiness skills



Family Literacy Program

Began 2018 ✓ NCCL Awarded \$35,000

• Provides:

- ✓ *Family Literacy:* Instruction & programs
 - > Facilitate literacy across family members & generations
 - Caregiver literacy support

- Need for additional tutors





Began 2011

✓ NCCL onboarded in October 2013

Alternate model for interlibrary loan service
Managed by NorthNet Library System

✓ In partnership with California State Library
✓ Supported with California Library Services Act funds



How It Works

• Patrons request a book that is not in the library's collection

- Item is ordered through Amazon
 ✓ Sent directly to the patron's address
 - ✓ Free of charge
- Patron returns the item to library staff
- The item may then be added to the library's collection



To Participate

• Registered borrower in good standing

Requests must be for books in print or audiobook format Titles must have a broad appeal and be appropriate for a public library use Adult, teen, or children books

• Cost limits

 \checkmark \$75 for audiobooks and foreign-language items

- \checkmark \$50 for all other qualifying items
- One request at a time
 - \checkmark Up to three per month.

✓ The Zip Book must be returned before you can submit another request.
