## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH FACILITIES FINANCING AUTHORITY FOR FUNDING UNDER THE COMMUNITY SERVICES INFRASTRUCTURE (CSI) GRANT PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$10,000,000

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 843 (2016), Section 52 established a competitive grant program to disburse funds for the purpose of creating and expanding community alternatives to incarceration; and

WHEREAS, the California Health Facilities Financing Authority, a public instrumentality of the State of California is authorized to disburse funding in support of acquiring and expanding facilities for the purpose of creating and expanding community alternatives to incarceration of Justice-Involved Individuals; and

WHEREAS, the California Health Facilities Financing Authority is currently inviting California counties to submit applications for the Community Services Infrastructure (CSI) Grant Program in support of the aforementioned goals, with applications due no later than December 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Housing and Community Services in partnership with Behavioral Health, Probation, local law enforcement agencies, courts and various other community partners, desires to acquire, and/or expand and/or renovate a facility, in order to provide services to Justice-Involved homeless individuals afflicted with mental health disorders, substance use disorders and/or trauma related disorders; and

WHEREAS, should grant funding be awarded, the County intends to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the participating agencies regarding the services to be provided as required by California Health Facilities Financing Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The County of Nevada shall submit to the California Health Facilities Financing Authority an application to participate in the Community Services Infrastructure (CSI) Grant Program, in the amount of up to \$10,000,000, to acquire and renovate a facility, in order to provide services to Justice-Involved homeless individuals afflicted with mental health disorders, substance use disorders and/or trauma related disorders.
- 2. The Nevada County Health and Human Services/Housing Division will complete the CSI Grant Program application before December 2, 2019, and the Health and Human Services Agency Director or his/her designee is authorized to sign the grant application and all documents that support the application.
