RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE FIRE SAFE COUNCIL OF NEVADA COUNTY, INC., FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE FIRE ASSISTANCE GRANT SUBGRANT NUMBER 17 SFA 81341

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisor's approved a letter of support on May 9, 2017 for a grant application whereby the Fire Safe Council of Nevada County, Inc., (FSCNC) and the County of Nevada (County) would partner to implement vegetation removal throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the FSCNC received Subaward Letter dated November 1, 2017 for subgrant number 17 SFA 81341 from the California Fire Safe Council, through a master grant from the U.S. Forest Service, for wildfire prevention, including hazardous fuels reduction and maintenance projects on non-federal land; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisor's approved an agreement with the FSCNC on August 14, 2018 for the subgrant award in the amount of \$200,000 which includes \$30,000 for grant administration from FSCNC and \$170,000 for vegetation removal by the County; and

WHEREAS, the FSCNC was able to secure additional funding of \$70,000, which includes \$7,000 for grant administration from FSCNC and \$63,000 for vegetation removal by the County; and

WHEREAS, an amendment is necessary to accept additional grant funds to be expended from the Fiscal Year 2019/2020 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approves the attached Amendment; and
- 2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute on behalf of Nevada County the Amendment between the County of Nevada and the Fire Safe Council of Nevada County, Inc.; and
- 3. Accepts \$63,000 in revenue to account number 1114-30107-703-1000-445200.

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT WITH

Fire Safe Council of Nevada County, Inc.

THIS AMENDMENT is executed this 12th day of November, 2019 by and between the Fire Safe Council of Nevada County, Inc. and COUNTY OF NEVADA. Said Amendment will amend the prior agreement between the parties entitled Hazardous Fuels Reduction along County Roads executed on August 14, 2018 by Resolution No. 18-408.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their agreement to allow or provide for additional hazardous fuels reduction with additional funding provided by the California Fire Safe Council Addendum to Subaward Agreement for 17 SFA 81341.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. This amendment shall be effective as of November 12, 2019.
- That section 2 of the contract shall have a revised Maximum Contract Price of \$233,000.
- 3. That section 3 of the contract shall have a revised Contract Termination Date of 12/31/19.
- 4. That the Schedule of Services, Exhibit "A" shall be replaced in its entirety with the attached Exhibit "A".
- 5. That the Schedule of Charges and Payment, Exhibit "B" shall be replaced in its entirety with the attached Exhibit "B".
- 6. That the Subaward Letter Dated November 1, 2017, Exhibit "D" shall be amended to include the attached Addendum to Subaward Agreement for 17 SFA 81341 dated 9/1/2017 letter dated September 17, 2019.
- 6. That in all other respects the prior agreement of the parties shall remain in full force and effect except as amended herein.

EXHIBIT "A"

SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

(amended November 12, 2019)

The County of Nevada Department of Public Works (hereinafter "Public Works") and the Fire Safe Council of Nevada County Inc. (hereinafter "FSCNC") agree to cooperate in the implementation of the "Egress/Ingress Fire Safety Paradigm Change Project" (hereinafter "Project") as outlined in the Project application to the California Fire Safe Council (attached hereto as Exhibit C) and as approved in the Project SubAward Letter dated November 1, 2017 (attached hereto as Exhibit D) to subgrant 17 SFA 81341 (hereinafter "Grant") and the Addendum to Subaward Agreement letter dated September 17, 2019.

Under the terms of this agreement, to the extent that the funding under this agreement allows, Public Works and its subcontractors will:

- Provide vegetation removal in the locations described in Exhibit C
- Provide matching funds of up to \$300,000 by the use of funds earmarked in the budget for roadside vegetation removal
- Provide documentation required per the Grant
- Provide regular invoicing to FSCNC

The FSCNC will:

- Compensate Public Works for vegetation removal in the locations described below and referenced in Exhibit C, up to \$233,000
- · Provide administration and address all other elements of the Grant
