SUBJECT: Resolution to Award the Contract for the 2019 McCourtney Road Landfill West

Ditch Drainage Improvements to Edward T. Navickis, for a total amount not to

exceed \$49,390

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: This contract impacts the Fiscal Year 2019/20 Solid Waste Western Budgets. There is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** On September 24, 2019, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 19-526 that approved the plans, specifications and cost estimate for the subject project and instructed the Nevada County Purchasing Division to advertise for bids. The bid was advertised in accordance with the Public Contract Code and posted on the County's ePurchasing website and bid notifications were emailed to appropriate firms.

The bids were opened on October 25, 2019, and are listed below:

1.	Edward T. Navickis	\$44,900
2.	Southwest General Engineering, Inc.	\$52,740
3.	Deschaine Enterprises, Inc.	\$72,500
4.	All American Construction, Inc.	\$117,700
	Engineer's Estimate	\$34,000

No bid protests were received. It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the low bidder, Edward T. Navickis, at the bid price of \$44,900.00, plus a 10% contingency of \$4,490.00, for a total of \$49,390.00.

This project includes preparation for and construction of 500 feet of shallow concrete V-ditch in an existing roadside drainage swale. Once the drainage is properly lined water will flow into the storm water collection system and safely leave the site. Work is scheduled to begin in January of 2020, and be completed within 10 working days, as allowed for in the contract.
