SUBJECT: Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding between Placer

County and Nevada County for Use of the Eastern Regional Material

**Recovery Facility (District 5)** 

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached resolution.

**FUNDING:** N/A.

**BACKGROUND:** On December 9, 1997, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved resolution 97-523, authorizing a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between Placer County and Nevada County for use of the Eastern Regional Material Recovery Facility for disposal of solid waste generated in eastern Nevada County. This 20-year agreement was scheduled to expire on December 9, 2017. Three subsequent Amendments (Resolutions 17-600, 18-587 & 19-631) extended the expiration date to January 31, 2020.

On June 11, 2019, per Resolution 19-255, the County awarded a franchise agreement to Tahoe Truckee Disposal Company, Inc. (DBA Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal or TTSD), for the collection, transportation, processing, and disposal of discarded material in the unincorporated area of Eastern Nevada County for a period of 10 years (July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2029). In order to address modifications outlined within the new franchise agreement and applicable regulatory changes since 1997, staff has been working with Placer County to prepare a revised agreement that would replace and supersede the existing outdated MOU.
