SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment #2 to the Personal Services Contract with The Salvation Army for the provision of CalFresh outreach and emergency shelter services at the Booth Family Center for CalWORKs families and to revise Exhibit "A" Schedule of Services to formalize the activation protocol for shelter nights and improve communication amongst all entities involved in the extreme weather sheltering events. (RES. 19-408) (RES. 19-566)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Services are funded by CalWORKs Mental Health, and Single Allocation funds, CalWORKs Housing Support Program funds, and CalFresh outreach funds. A budget amendment is not necessary and there are no County general fund dollars required by the Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Under this Agreement, The Salvation Army will continue to provide CalFresh outreach and emergency shelter services at the Booth Family Center providing shelter and support for CalWORKs participant families and up to 20 shelter days for homeless families during extremely cold winter nights at their main facility on Alta Street in Grass Valley.

The Contractor will continue to provide emergency shelter services (rooms) to families referred by the County Department of Social Services and related case management services at their Booth Family Center as outlined in their original contract agreement.

It is recommended that the attached contract amendment is approved as the services provided will address emergency needs of our homeless population on extremely cold winter nights. This amendment will formalize the activation protocol and criteria for extreme weather shelter nights that will improve communication amongst all entities involved in the extreme weather sheltering events.
