RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$238,020 FOR THE RENEWAL OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (SAMHSA) CENTER FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (CMHS) COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/20

WHEREAS, a SAMHSA (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration) Federal Block Grant is available to the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department; and


WHEREAS, the monies awarded for this Program will be used to continue to fund community-based systems of care for providing mental health services to adults with co-occurring substance abuse addiction and mental health disorders through Turning Point Community Program's Peer run Crisis Insite Respite Center (CIRC) and the Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) operated by Sierra Mental Wellness Group; and

WHEREAS, CIRC utilizes peers to help engage clients during an urgent psychiatric event and develop their own Wellness and Recovery Action Plan, while the CSU provides intensive mental health services over short periods of time to prevent clients from further suffering associated with longer periods of time being in crisis; and

WHEREAS, the approved SAMHSA grant allocation for Fiscal Year 2019/20 is \$238,020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby accepts the grant funds in the amount of \$238,020 for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Center for Mental Health Services (CMHS) Community Mental Health Services Block Grant (MHBG) Program for Fiscal Year 2019/20.
