**BACKGROUND:**

The Board of Supervisors appoints one member to represent the interests of local school districts on the First 5 Nevada County Children & Families First Commission. Superintendent of Schools Scott Lay was appointed to this position on August 28, 2018. Superintendent Lay submitted his application for reappointment on February 10, 2020, and indicated that he would like to continue serving on the commission.
