OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

ADOPT A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Nevada County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County will receive an estimated \$3,201,827 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2020/21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which Nevada County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the Nevada County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help Nevada County maintain and rehabilitate 14 roads throughout Nevada County and add active transportation infrastructure on numerous projects in the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that Nevada County's roads are in an "at-risk" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of proposed projects, Exhibit A, are approved and adopted and will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2020-21 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
