

## RESOLUTION No.07-035

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

## **RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING REVENUE ALLOCATION OF HEALTH AND WELFARE REALIGNMENT FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, The State of California adopted "Realignment" legislation via the 1991 statutes, shifting certain Health, Mental Health and Social Service programs from the responsibility of the State to counties, and also transferring increased portions of sales tax and motor vehicle fee revenues to counties to pay for the increased county cost for these programs; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 95-486 allocated Realignment funds within each of the statutorily required Subaccounts to specific departments; and

WHEREAS, the County has changed accounting systems, making the accounting detail regarding account and revenue codes specified in Resolution 95-486 obsolete; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommend the allocation methodology be reaffirmed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nevada County Board of Supervisor's allocates both Sales Tax and Motor Vehicle License Fee (MVLF) Health & Welfare Realignment funds as follows:

Mental Health Subaccount	100.00%	Behavioral Health
Social Services Subaccount		Social Services Public Health/CA Children Services
	<u> </u>	Juvenile Hall
Health Subaccount (remainder of revenues after CMSP offset)	76.70%	Public Health (CMSP offset) Public Health Environmental Health

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that each annual County Budget adopted by the Board of Supervisors will make specific allocations in regards to Health & Welfare Realignment revenues and related expenses.
