<u>SUBJECT</u> :	Resolution approving an agreement between the County of Nevada and the Nevada County Consolidated Fire District (NCCFD) pertaining to the County's Defensible Space Inspection Program, with payment to NCCFD for providing program management in the amount of \$51,200, for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, and authorizing the Board of Supervisors to execute the agreement.

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Adopt the Resolution

**FUNDING:** These services will be paid for from the Office of Emergency Services Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget and is a budgeted expense as discussed in the Budget Subcommittee. It is recommended to approve this contract renewal in coordination with the updated Hazardous Vegetation Ordinance to ensure operational objectives will be timely implemented

**BACKGROUND:** In 1988 after the 49er Fire, Nevada County and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection entered into an informal agreement to initiate a fire prevention program for Nevada County. Initially the program was funded by FEMA grant funds and later a combination of FEMA and Forest Reserve Funds.

On March 26, 2019 the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 19-128, approving an agreement encourage greater communication, cooperation, and coordination between the County, and Nevada County Consolidated Fire District (NCCFD) for management of the DSI Program for a one-year period from April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020

The Office of Emergency Services wishes to continue this agreement with NCCFD to provide day to day DSI Program management services for a one-year period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 for consideration of providing these services the County will pay to NCCFD \$51,200
