SUBJECT:Resolution to Award the Contract for the 2020 Nevada County Annual
Striping Project, Contract No. 426637, to Traffic Limited for a Total
Amount of \$195,294.64

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The project is budgeted in the fiscal year 2020/21 Road Maintenance budget. Funding is provided by Highway User Tax Account (HUTA) and Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds. There is no impact to the County's General Fund and no budget amendment is needed.

BACKGROUND:

On March 24, 2020, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 20-091 that approved the plans, specifications and cost estimate for the subject project and instructed the Nevada County Purchasing Division to advertise for bids. The bids were opened on April 30, 2020 and are listed below: **Biddor Bid**

*There were minor math errors on the second low bidder which did not affect the outcome of the bidding process.

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the low bidder, Traffic Limited, at the bid price of \$177,540.58 plus a 10% contingency of \$17,754.06 for a total of \$195,294.64.

This project includes striping of approximately 97 miles of County roadways. Work is scheduled to begin in July of 2020 and be completed within 35 working days, as allowed for in the contract.
