## AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH PORTER SCOTT, A PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the term of the Contract from June 30, 2020, to June 30, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3, Contract Termination Date, is hereby extended to June 30, 2021.
