SUBJECT: Resolution accepting the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Program COVID-19 Supplemental from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$82,549 with a 50% matching fund requirement for use during the period of January 27, 2020 through October 26, 2021 and amending the FY 2020-21 Office of Emergency Services Budget (4/5 Affirmative Vote Required)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: FY 2020 assignment of federal grant funds passed through the State in the amount of \$82,549 plus \$41,275 in County matching funds. These funds will be received in the Office of Emergency Services budget. A budget amendment has been included for approval.

BACKGROUND:

Funds provided under the Emergency Management Performance Grant Supplemental (EMPG-S) must be used to support activities related to the County's public health and emergency management activities supporting the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency. These funds are a non-competitive allocation based grant from Cal OES. This EMPG-S funding period of performance will be from January 27, 2020 through October 26, 2021.

The amount approved for Nevada County is \$82,549 with a 50% matching requirement. The matching requirement will be met by a combination of the General Fund allocation to the Office of Emergency Services (OES) budget and work to be performed by other County departments on behalf of the OES program related to COVID-19 response.
