## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT (EMPG) PROGRAM COVID-19 SUPPLEMENTAL FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF $\$ 82,549$ WITH A $50 \%$ MATCHING FUND REQUIREMENT FOR USE DURING THE PERIOD OFJANUARY 27, 2020 THROUGH OCTOBER 26, 2021 AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES BUDGET (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, the U.S Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to assist state, local, and tribal governments for public health and emergency management activities supporting the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, Cal OES applied for and was approved for Fiscal Year 2020 EMPG Program COVID-19 Supplemental (EMPG-S) funding through FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the EMPG-S funding is a non-competitive allocation-based grant; and
WHEREAS, Nevada County received notification of the subrecipient award for EMPG-S funding on June 16, 2020 in the amount of $\$ 82,549$ for reimbursement of eligible expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby directs:

1. That the County of Nevada accept the subrecipient award for EMPG-S grant funding in the amount of $\$ 82,549$ for the grant period January 27, 2020 through October 26, 2021 to be used for reimbursement of eligible expenditures.
2. That the Director of Emergency Services is authorized to fulfill the requirements of the Fiscal Year 2020 EMPG-S.
3. That the Auditor-Controller amend the Office of Emergency Services Fiscal Year 2020/21 budget as follows:
